Seven members of our staff had the privilege of participating in the annual Volunteer Florida Emergency Support Function 15 Convening.

### **ERT ACADEMY**



The Early Response Team Academy was a comprehensive training program designed to equip participants with the necessary skills and knowledge to effectively respond to emergencies and disasters in their communities. The academy consisted of a series of workshops and hands-on exercises, all aimed at preparing individuals to provide early assistance in times of disaster.

We were joined by 37 registered participants, including 5 trainers, and leadership from the Florida Conference and UMCOR.

Throughout the academy, participants learned about various aspects of disaster response, including basic early response, site evaluation, cleaning out a flooded home, tarping skills, chainsaw safety, and more. Experienced instructors led sessions including the comprehensive UMCOR ERT training program which ensured that participants are well-rounded in their understanding of disaster response.

The academy also provided opportunities for practical application, with simulated disaster scenarios allowing participants to put their training into action. These exercises included evaluating a house using the criteria provided in the class, physically tarping a roof, and applying chainsaw safety to cut logs provided by the camp. These exercises helped participants develop critical thinking skills, teamwork abilities, and the ability to adapt to dynamic and challenging situations.

The academy fostered a sense of community among participants, encouraging collaboration among individuals from diverse backgrounds and experiences. This sense of camaraderie not only enhanced the learning experience but also laid the foundation for effective collaboration in real-world emergency situations.

Overall, the Early Response Team Academy was a valuable opportunity for participants to gain the skills, knowledge, and confidence needed to serve their communities as a caring Christian presence. By completing the academy, participants were better equipped to make a meaningful difference in times of crisis and contribute to the resilience and recovery of their communities.



# CHURCH PREPAREDNESS

Church disaster plans will be due May, 1, 2024. Each church is expected to complete a disaster plan and submit it by Wednesday May 1, through the online Church Dashboard.

This plan walks through church assets, plan for securing buildings, who to connect with before and after a storm. The plan also offers direction on reaching out to congregants after a storm. It is important to have this information on hand prior to a disaster so that it may be easily accessed in a time of need. It is recommended that the plan be stored both online and in a printed copy.
