# **MATTRESS EVENT**

In partnership with Faith UMC in Fort Myers, our Long-Term Recovery team hosted a Mattress distribution event for Hurricane Ian survivors. The event came about as our team connected with TempurSealy for a donation of 264 mattresses designated for hurricane survivors. The team worked with clients, local United Methodist Churches, and the Lee County Long Term Recovery Group- a group of organizations working on Hurricane Ian Recovery - to get the word out for those that needed new mattresses.

The pickup event was held on February 9th, 2024. The team facilitated the pickup drive through at Faith UMC, with a team of staff and volunteers. Much-appreciated muscle was used getting the mattresses (Foam mattresses separately packed in boxes) from the semi-trailer on pallets to the line formed for the recipient's vehicles. We are grateful for our volunteers: Charles, Colby, and Kathleen, and the amazing staff!

By the end of the day, 236 mattresses were distributed to approximately 145 households of hurricane survivors.

Many of the recipients receiving a mattress were thankful to be sleeping on a new mattress that night, reporting that still, over a year later, they did not have the funds to purchase mattresses after Hurricane Ian. Many have been sleeping on air mattresses or still sleeping on storm damaged mattresses until this point. We are very grateful to play a role in something that can greatly impact a survivor's day to day life.
